



Important Information Regarding Your New Sanitation Service Provider For The City of Cumming.

Attention All Residential & Commercial Customers.

- ◆ **Your new trash service begins** the week of April 1, 2018. Do not use the Red Oak trash cart prior to this date.
- ◆ **You must have your trash curbside the night before** your scheduled pickup day. Having your trash out the night before will reduce service issues.
- ◆ **You will receive** a 95 gallon cart for trash. All trash must be bagged and in the containers provided. Cart will be delivered to the location where you will need to have your cart placed for service. This includes both residential and commercial customers.
- ◆ **If Additional Carts are needed:** Please contact the City of Cumming Utility Office, 770-781-2020.
- ◆ **Important Notice: Construction Debris Is Not Accepted:** Red Oak equipment will not take any construction debris, rock, dirt, trees, stumps, logs, sod, rail road ties, concrete, paint or oil. We will not accept this material.
- ◆ Packing Peanuts must be bagged and tied off to prevent the packing peanuts from blowing all over.
- ◆ **Yard Waste** is not accepted.
- ◆ **Those interested** in recycling must call the Red Oak office to set up this service, at no additional charge. Recycling service begins May 1, 2018. All recycling material **must** meet the recycling guidelines. **We are unable to accept glass in recycling. SEE RECYCLING GUIDELINES ATTACHED OR ON OUR WEBSITE.**
- ◆ **Holiday Schedule:** We observe six holidays per year starting with New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. If the holiday falls on or before your scheduled service day, your holiday week service day will be the following day. You will NOT be affected by holidays that fall on the weekend. Holiday Example, on Memorial Day, Monday, we do not service. If your service day is on Monday, your holiday week service day is Tuesday. This continues until Friday customers are serviced on Saturday.
- ◆ **Before you throw away an item, consider if someone in need can use it.** We have neighbors in need that are struggling through circumstances outside their control. First Quarter 2018 Highlights

Promoted former Assistant City Administrator **Phil Higgins** to the role of **City Administrator**, following the retirement of the former City Administrator in December; eliminated the Assistant Administrator position to save the City substantial salary and benefit costs.

Bid out several of the City's contract services to lower costs; awarded the garbage pickup services contract for residents within the City Limits to **Red Oak Sanitation**, which will **add curbside recycling** once a week at no additional cost to citizens, while saving the City approximately \$160,000/year.



Approved a study to evaluate the City's Planning & Zoning fees to **potentially institute impact fees so new development contributes to increased infrastructure costs**; adopted a temporary building and development moratorium during the approximate 6-month study to allow time to **plan for responsible future development in the City**.

Adopted the City's first **Noise Ordinance** for residents and businesses within the City Limits, and named a **Code Enforcement Officer** to ensure City Ordinances are properly enforced.

Dissolved the Cumming Fair Authority to **return full control of the Cumming Fairgrounds to the Mayor and City Council**; we are currently in the process of establishing a **Fair Advisory Board**, which will be comprised of 5 to 20 members from the community who will make recommendations to the Mayor and Council concerning ways to improve the Cumming Country Fair & Festival.

Partnered with the Forsyth County School System and Sheriff's Department to hold their annual **Ghost Out and Teen Maze** event on March 24 at the Cumming Fairgrounds at no cost; previously rotated among the 5 public high schools, this venue change allows students from all Forsyth middle and high schools, as well as private and homeschool students and parents, to attend the event.



Established a new Cumming Fairgrounds' event: **Fridays at the Fairgrounds**, which will be held every third Friday during warm-weather months **beginning April 20** featuring food trucks, a cruise-in car show, live music, hot air balloon rides, and inflatables and games for kids.

On the Horizon

Establishing **additional community events**, including a music festival in early summer and expanded July 4th event at the Fairgrounds, as well as a Christmas parade through downtown ending with a large-scale Christmas festival at the Fairgrounds.

Laying groundwork for **creation of the City Center**, a community gathering space featuring walkable retail and restaurant spaces, small-scale event venues, and green spaces.

Looking for **cost-saving measures** across all City Departments, and **fostering community partnerships** to bring positive economic development projects to the City.
